FAF version 1.10.1100 (Update 10)

Applicable Software

Family Assessment Form version 1.0.1000 (build 1000) and later.

Installation

Apply this update to version 1.0.1000 (build 1000) or later.

Download the file FAF_Update_10.exe and execute.

Features and resolved issues for all updates

Version 1.0.1001 Build 1001 (Hotfix 1), Release date: 8/1/05

Printing a report or form when no Windows printers have been defined causes a run-time error.

The Add/Edit/Delete buttons on the FFF database maintenance form did not work properly when changing Goals/Methods.

Running a FFF report (single or multiple) that shows the change between two assessments would instead show the change between the first and last assessments. This might also display the message "There are no results that match the query or the rating data is incomplete".

The Assessment Contact Information on the Assessment Date tab of the Case Log form did not allow scrolling.

A run time error occurred when entering a date on the Others at Home tab of the Intake Data form if it was the first entry and the Add function had not been selected.

A run time error could occur under some conditions when running a Service Plan report.

Corrected data formats on Contacts Summary report and Demographics report for international use.

The Service Plan report could contain extraneous concerns.

If the first Case Log is entered without first selecting the Add button a run time error occurs.

On the Case Log form, the Assessment Date and Worker tabs could be selected when no Case Logs had been entered.

Version 1.0.1002 Build 1002 (Hotfix 2), Release date: 1/7/06

When a caregiver rating was left blank on the spreadsheet version of the FFF a runtime error could occur.

When a duplicate Case Name is entered a warning message will now be displayed.

Added the option to change the location and filename of the Error Log File.

Viewing the properties on an FFF report that had no workers could cause a run time error.

When adding a child to the Children Placed on the Closing form, Closing Outcome tab, no Children or Where Placed choices were shown.

The Goals and Methods lists on the Strengths/Concerns tab of the Service Plan did not have scroll bars.

Added additional case information to the top of the FFF spreadsheet printout.

Added Program Type and Program Office to the filter selections on the FFF Reports.

Added an entry to allow Error Log directory selection on the Database Option form.

Added a Print button on the FFF spreadsheet form.

On the Login form a sound may occur when the Enter key was used.

The N/A function on the full text FFF entry form did not work correctly.

Version 1.0.1003 Build 1003 (Update 3), Release date: 11/29/2006

New features

- Added FFF Item report.
- Added Additional Factors Option. Corrected several FFF Factor/Item/Rating database entry problems.
- Added a pop up menu to enter rating and N/A values on the spreadsheet version of the FFF entry.
- Added an option on Case Log Report to show all assessments for a Case Log.
- Added an auto-generate Case Number that can be enabled on the Options form by an administrator.
- Added ability to re-assign Case Logs to another worker on the Worker Pool form.

Resolved issues

- A user could run FFF Reports on cases that were not assigned to the user when full case access was not granted.
- The N/A selection on the full version of the FFF entry did not work. The N/A option would be cleared when leaving an Item.
- When adding an Assessment Type in the Database Maintenance form an error message indicating that a numeric entry was required would be displayed followed by a run time error.
- On the Database Maintenance form, a Response could be edited by double clicking an entry.
- On the Contacts form, if the first contact was entered without using the Add button a run time error occurred.
- On the Case Log form, using a search filter that resulted in no Case Logs, the Search and Search All buttons were not enabled when Case Logs existed. The Delete button was not always enabled when Case Logs were present.
- When a Case Log search criteria is used, a new Case Log may not be shown when added due to the search criteria selected by the user. The search mode is now changed to Show All when a Case Log is added.
- Changed the nomenclature on the Database Maintenance form, Family Factors and Behavioral tabs to reflect Factors, Items and Ratings.
- On Case Log Report if a worker was available in the first column, a comma was printed.
- The first column title was missing on the Case Log Report.
- Under some conditions, a Case Log with a duplicate number or name could be added.
- If a new Case Log with a duplicate Case Name was added, an error message containing the Case Number instead of the Case Name was displayed.
- When adding a new Case Log and a Case Number was not entered a run time error occurred.
- A Case Number is now required when entering a new Case Log.
- If a Case Log had no Caregivers, some FFF reports resulted in a run-time error when run.
- In the Database Maintenance form, Behavioral Factors and Items could be edited by double-clicking on the selected line.
- Under some conditions a report that have a multiple line item would have two or more line printed over each other.
- On the FFF reports duplicate Case Log Names would not be listed in the drop down box; single Case Logs can now be selected by either Case Log Name or Case Log Number.
- On the Contacts form if Add was selected on the Worker tab to add a worker without clicking Save or Cancel and then if Add was clicked on the Contact tab a run time error occurred.
- The Contact report would sometimes list the same worker multiple times.
- An Assessment Type on the Case Log form could be edited to be the same as an existing assessment type.
- Entering the first Assessment Contact Information on the Assessment tab of the Case Log form would sometime cause a run time error.
- Leaving a rating blank after deleting it on the spreadsheet version of the FFF entry could cause a run time error when saved.
- If no caregivers have been entered for a Case Log, an FFF report for a single Case Log would display the message "There are no results that match the query or the rating data is incomplete" even if valid ratings had been entered.
- When sorting the Referrals table on the Tables tab of the Database Maintenance form, the sorting was displayed the next time it was displayed. This affected the Referral selection when adding a referral on the Workers/Referrals tab of the Contact form.
- If the Case Log Report did not have Case Logs that matched the selection requirements a run time could occur.
- If no Service Plan initial date is defined the Service Plan report could cause a run time error.
- If a Method on the Service Plan began with a numeric character, a run time error would occur when opening the Service Plan.

Version 1.0.1004 Build 1004 (Update 3A), Release date: 12/7/2006

- If a user that is does not have admin rights selects Family Function Factors reports a run time errors occurs.

Added plug-in capability

Resolved issues

When running the Case Log report a pop-up always occurred stating the printer orientation must be changed to landscape, even if it had already been set to landscape in the preceding printer dialog box.
If the FFF report was run for single case that had no FFF ratings a run-time error would occur.
Contact Report contained large gaps.

The Assessment Type selection can be re-ordered in the Database Maintenance window.
Larger application window (uses 1024x786)
Added report date to reports.
Added Agency name to reports.
Closing Summary Report can now be run with selected Case Logs
Agency name has been added to the Closing Summary and Demographics reports
Added Plugin capability and Plugin management.

Resolved issues

On the Intake form, Other Data tab, the Number of past involvements with CPS will default to 0 if no entry is made before saving.
On the Intake form, Other Data tab, the Length of current involvement with CPS will default to 0 if no entry is made before saving.
When a 1000 Assessment license was added the assessments were not included in the total.
The age range for caregivers on the Demographics report was clarified because the ending value of one range overlapped the beginning value of the next range.
A run time error occurred when a Case Log Summary report was run by a user without full case access.
If the Assessment Type selection table was customized, the Assessment Type control on the Assessment Date tab of the Case Log window could be grayed out for the first assessment.
If a User account was disabled the user could still log in.
When deleting a User Factor a run time error occurred.
When a Service Plan report was canceled, the mouse pointer hourglass remained.
A runtime error occurred if no user accounts existed in the database.
Extra blank lines occurred in the Case Log Report.
The Assessment Dates on the Case Log report were incorrect when All Assessments was selected.
In some circumstances multi-line formatting would break up text incorrectly.
If the Assessment Types were modified using the database maintenance utility, the Assessment Type selections may not display correctly on the Case Log report.
Some of the totals of the Demographics report could be incorrect.
After adding a new Factor, a new Item could not be added.
When delete an Additional Factor, a run time error occurred.
If the type of contact was not defined for a contact on the Case Log Summary report a run time error occurred.
Updated nomenclature in the Family Factor pop up messages for the Database Maintenance window.

New features

Data can be pasted into most textboxes.

Resolved issues

The ordering arrows on the Tables tab of the Database Maintenance were missing.
Printing multi-lines text that contained line breaks did not print correctly. This was seen on the Current Contact report.
The Service Plan report showed incorrect Improvement values if only one assessment had ratings.
Under certain conditions the Service Plan could contain extraneous Concerns.

New features

The Behavioral Concerns entry window has been revised. Each child can now be rating as Unrated, No and Yes. The question or section can now be marked as N/A.
The BCO Items report was added.
The BCO Outline report was added.
The BCO Complete/Incomplete Item Checklist

Resolved issues

On the Demographics report, the age description could overlap the count.
Fixed left margin on Demographics report
If a non-administrator user ran the Demographics report a run time error occurred.
The Age Range for the caregivers and children on the Demographics would alternate between default and custom each time the report was run. If the custom ranges were not defined no data would be shown.
The FAF window size was not saved if the window controls were used to close the FAF. If File > Exit was used, the window size was saved.
A run time error sometimes occurred when changing between Items or Sections in the FFF entry.
When using the Item N/A on the FFF entry and error message, "Rating must be a numeric entry" would be displayed.
Some Family Functional Factor ratings would be changed if the Section N/A checkbox was used.
If large amounts of text were used on the text boxes of the Progress/Homework tab of the Contacts window, the Contacts report might not print them correctly.
On the Worker Tab of the Case Log Window, if Edit Worker Pool was selected and no worker had been assigned to the worker pool, a run time error occurred.
The Assessment Type date or type could not be changed under some conditions.

New features

In Options Preferences, Report/Forms Sections to Include, Additional Factors may now be selected independently.
Added the Secondary ID field to the Case Log information and appropriate reports and forms.
Reports and forms can now be viewed without printing.

Resolved issues

The BCO Items, BCO Outline and BCO Complete/Incomplete Item Checklist reports were shown on the main menu in the Express version.
On the Database selection window, if Cancel was selected, the Save and Cancel buttons became grayed out and the hourglass mouse pointer was display.
When opening the help file for the Pro or Express version, an erroneous error message was displayed.
Added database filename to Splash and About screens.
Options Preferences, Report/Forms Sections to Include did not always correctly reflect the previously saved settings.
Additional Factors may now be selected independently.
If the Case Log information was changed after the Case Log was closed, the Case Log was re-opened.
Contact Reports with multiple contacts and large text entries did not print correctly.
The page numbers on the Closing Summary report did not always print correctly.
If no Additional Factors were defined and a Additional Factor or Item was selected, a run time error occurred.
If a change was saved on the Progress/Homework tab of the Contact screen, the selected contact would be set to the first contact.
Updated captions on the Behavioral Concerns screen to reflect Factors and Items.
The data for the Organization table could not be edited on the Tables tab of the Database Maintenance window.
The database revision was not always detected correctly.

New features

Added Assessment Type to FAF Outline and BCO Outline forms.
Added Service Summary Report.
Added Citizenship field to the Caregiver and Children tabs on the Intake Data window.
Created xml schema file for Data Export.
Add preview to forms.

Resolved issues

The Case Summary report did not print until the View function was used.
In the Database Exchange, the Additional Factors definitions would not export unless the Database Tables are also exported.
The Contact Summary started a new page after listing referrals.
After viewing a Contact Summary report and the FAF was closed, the FAF did not completely exit.
The Services Provided Items on the Services Provided of the Contacts Window now scrolls.
If a printer is available when the FAF starts then becomes unavailable, a runtime error could occur when printing.
Fixed several problems with the Data Export.
If the Goals From Service Plan on the Goal Outcomes tab of the Closing window was clicked and no Service Problems existed, a popup message asking the user to save would repeat if No or Cancel was selected. A run time error may also occur.
A printing error may occur when printing if a different printer other than the default is selected.

Resolved issues

If there was no caregiver name in the Service Plan report a run time error would occur.
If an entry for Others At Home was present in a case log, running a Case Summary report would cause a run time error.
When opening the Case Log window, a run time sometimes occurred.
The Contact Summary did not display/print the contacts for all Case Logs. A run time error sometimes occurred.
If the user did not have file write permission in the FAF application directory, an error occurred when running the FFF report.

Version 1.10.1100 (Update 10), Release date: 11/23/09

New features

Added FFF Concerns Report.
The Contact Summary report now allows selection by both Case Log dates and Contact dates.
The Demographics report case log selection has been improved.
Changed printer dialog box to improve operation.

Resolved issues

The Data Export file could contain characters that are invalid in an XML file.
The Behavioral Concerns data in the export file may contain empty child id tags.
The URI reference to the faf.xsd file in the export file now points to the correct location.
A run time error may occur during a data export after creating the complete export file.
A run time error would sometimes occur when printing the BCO Items report.
If a Family Functioning Factor report is printed for a case log that does not contain any children entries a run time error occurs.
A run time error occurred when a case log is entered and the case log search criteria is set not to display the new case log.
If a large amount of text is entered for a contact note, the Current Contact report would take several minutes to print.
An overflow run time error would sometimes occur during a Data Export.
When a different printer was selected the printout was sent to the former printer.
Printing the spreadsheet version of the Family Function Factors may result in a run time error.
If no user accounts are entered, setting up the default admin account caused a run time error.
If no assessments had been entered, running the FAF Outline report resulted in a run time error.
If no assessments had been entered, running the BCO Outline report resulted in a run time error.
The calendar button on the Service Report did not work.
The dates on the calendar control would sometimes have a very small font.
